



Dear Property Owners,

Due to security concerns and issues the general code for the gates, key, key, 6879 is being discontinued as of today. No more general code will be issued since most members have already requested and received a personal 6-digit entry code and this code or your remote clicker should be used from Feb 8 forward. Instructions for using your personal code will follow below. There will also be a link to these instructions on the web site under gate access.

If you have not already got your personal 6 digit code please go to <http://www.pkhillssassociation.com/gate-access.html> and fill out the application information. If you did not make note of your code when you received it please fill out the form again. Access codes were preassigned to all POA members last summer so there will be no delay in receiving the code.

Gate code instructions:

If you have been to the web site this year and filled out the application for your personal gate code, pool card registration and remote clicker registration, thank you very much. As many of you will be finding out, the old code (key, key 6789) expired Feb 8, 2016. Your new 6 digit code is personal and you should not give it out. To use the code at the entrance push "key" only once and then enter the 6 digit code. The first three digits entered without "key" will have the gate call the cell phone that you gave as your best number and you can answer, speak, and then press 9 on your keypad to open the gate for guests or deliveries you are expecting. Alternatively a visitor can scroll to your name at the gate and also dial the 3 digit code to have the gate call you (do not press "key" prior to using the 3-digit call resident code. Your name will only be displayed at the gate which is your normal or closest entrance gate. For example if you access your lot or home from gate 4, your name is not displayed at gates 1, 2 or 3 however your remote clicker and personal code work on all gates except new gate 5. The developer put a different system on Gate 5 not compatible with the original gates. Gate 5 will be activated along with instructions for access by March 1.

On the directory the administrator code is 000.

So that you can identify that a gate is calling you please enter your specific gate telephone number into your cell phone so it displays the caller ID as PK Gate # or simple Gate #. Occasionally someone may accidentally pick your name from the directory to call for entry. Please do not open the gate for anyone you do not expect or do not know as this could compromise our security. Here are the gate phone numbers. Gate 1 (940) 779-4289, Gate 2 (940) 779-2053, Gate 3 (940) 779-9041, Gate 4 (940) 779-2096.

As a side note, people at the gate can use the dial pad to dial your phone and speak to you from the gate. If they dial your number manually from the key pad the "9" key gate open command will not work until they hang up and dial the 3-digit code that calls you from the directory.

Please give visitors and contractors directions to your specific gate number. Here is a map link to the PK Hills area <https://www.google.com/maps/@32.9753098,-98.3828655,6005m/data=!3m1!1e3?hl=en> directions from various locations can be given to your gate by zooming in on the map and right clicking on your gate, choose "directions to here" and then enter your visitor's address in directions "from or starting point" line which can be as simple as typing Dallas, TX, Austin, TX or Houston, TX, press enter and then send the resulting link and directions to your visitor. Gate numbers are on the center and one post of each gate. Gates are numbered from the south with even numbers on the west (lake) side of 16. The small double gate on the east side is #1 (2 is across 16) and the large main double gate is #3 (4 is across 16).

Thank you for your patience during this changeover to a more secure gate entry method.
